## **A Note of Gratitude: When Opposition Clarifies Opportunity**

Today, we thank Rep. Karlee Provenza for the role she played in bringing Rebecca Bextel's leadership into clear view. Last February, a now well-known photograph taken on the House floor was meant to expose. Instead, it revealed — highlighting the kind of principled, steady leadership many Wyoming conservatives have been waiting to see. What some dubbed “Checkgate” became a moment of clarity, a reminder that conviction still matters.

Rebecca Bextel did not retreat. She stood firm in defense of conservative principles during a time when too many in Cheyenne have shown a willingness to compromise them. Recent changes in legislative rules have raised serious concerns about the protection of First Amendment expression — concerns that deserve careful attention. Those moments have now contributed to something larger: a growing movement grounded in constitutional fidelity and seriousness of purpose.

To Rep. Provenza: thank-you. Your criticism has directly led to establishing a new constitutional conservative coalition in our state.

To Scott Merrifeld: respect. You advocated for people to join the party that best represents their ideology.

To Gail Symons: you're welcome. This election happens in November. As you said. "careful what you wish for."

All party leaders can agree that the general election must remain the decisive contest, where all voters regardless of ideology have their political voice echoed by the candidates they cast their votes. A healthy political system requires real choices — not assumptions of inevitability.

The Constitution Party of Wyoming is committed to ensuring Wyoming voters have a legitimate, principled alternative — real choices. We will contest open seats, challenge liberal candidates, while ensuring that conservative votes are not split. We embrace Ethics over Emotion, honor Principles over Politics, and desire to restore the Constitution over Compromises.
